EXHIBITION

Held under the rules and regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW, in conjunction with the NSW Cavy Club Inc, and judged to the standards of the Australian National Cavy Council. All exhibitors must be a current member of an affiliated ANCC Cavy club.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR (classes 52 – 58)

Cavies must be owner and exhibited by a junior (under 18yrs). The cavy must also be entered in the corresponding general class.

UNSTANDARDISED (class 59)

No awards are given in this class. It is to showcase new varieties holding a working title only. Judges are to complete assessment forms for each variety. Although there is no entry fee for this class, please note that to be eligible to the Sydney Royal Show, the exhibitor must pay the \$10 entry fee.

CLASSES MARKED

Will be divided into each different breed, colour or variety that are entered.

PASSES

Each exhibitor will receive one admission ticket. In addition bench slips will be issued to allow entry to gate 10 with a vehicle, for unloading **ONLY.**

PARKING

A pass allowing you into the ground to unload/pick up your cavies will be provided.

Exhibitors must **BOOK** parking for the rest of the day. This is available to members \$20 per day, \$40 for trailers, in P5 exhibitors car park, please indicate on your entry form. Or you must arrange other parking for the day. **STRICTLY NO PARKING** on the show grounds or near entry gate.

PAVILLION

The Cavy Section will be located in the Wynne Pavilion. The pavilion will be open to exhibitors from 7am. Cavies must be penned by 8.30am and remain on exhibition until 5pm.

VETTING

Cavies must be penned by 8.30am at which time they will be inspected by the RAS appointed Veterinary Surgeon, before judging.

CAVIES

Exhibitors must provide a carpet square (toweling or similar material) 50cm x 50cm for lining the exhibition pens. All cavies to be shown on a show board height not to exceed 5cm from table.

All owners and representatives are responsible for the punctual benching of cavies. A cavy must be benched once the number is called. It is at the Chief Stewards discretion to disqualify any cavy that is not benched for judging by the third call.

SALE OF CAVIES

The sale of cavies/livestock at the Sydney Royal Cavy Show is prohibited.

OTHER CAVIES/PETS

No other cavies/pets other than those entered in the 2010 Sydney Royal Cavy Show shall be permitted into the Wynne Pavilion.

SYDNEY ROYAL CAVY SHOW 2010

NSW CAVY CLUB INC. SHOW REGULATIONS

- All cavies entered will be judged as per the Australian National Cavy Council (ANCC) standards.
- All exhibitors must be a current member of the NSW Cavy Club Inc. or a club affiliated to the ANCC.
- All judges, (with the exception of the judge of the junior exhibitor section) partners and/or immediate family member of those judges may not enter cavies at NSW Cavy Club Inc. show at which they are officiating as judge.
- No cavy previously owned by a Judge shall be eligible for exhibition under that Judge until a period of three months has elapsed from the date of change of ownership, except when the Judge has been changed after the closing date of entries.
- Every cavy exhibited at the show must at the time of the show be owned by the exhibitor in whose name it is entered.
- Cavies must be entered in the name given to it by the breeder, using the breeders stud prefix first and the cavy's given name. In the instance where no pedigree has been given with the cavy, or the breeder is unknown, no stud prefix is to be used.
- Ear tags with the corresponding pen numbers must be attached to the left ear – with the exception of longhairs, where it is to be placed on the top corner of the show board. Any other form of identification of any cavy by the exhibitor could result in disqualification of that animal.
- Ear tags must be in place when the cavy is penned.
- All cavies must be shown on a mat or show board height not to exceed 5cm.
- NO talking is permitted by exhibitors at the judging bench whilst the judging is in progress. Any communications must be left until after the judging is concluded, with the exception of those comments relating to the possible risk of health of other exhibits by the presence of an exhibit.
- The steward shall be responsible for marking all the necessary awards on the judging slip, which must contain only the corresponding ear tag numbers of the exhibits, after completing each class, the slip is forwarded to the official entries secretary promptly. No alteration may be made to the awards as shown on the slip for any class after it has been initialed by the Judge.
- The Judge can disqualify any cavy which they think is unfit for showing
- The Judge may order any person or cavy from the competition for bad conduct of one or both.
- The Judge's decision is final – no discussion will be entered into
- All owners or representatives are responsible for the punctual benching of cavies. A cavy must be brought to the bench when the exhibit number has been called. Entries that are not on the bench on the third call will be disqualified.
- All cavies entered in the general classes will be benched by the owner or his representative.
- All cavies entered in the junior exhibitor classes, must be benched by the junior owner/exhibitor only.
- All cavies entered in the novice exhibitor class, must be benched by the novice exhibitor only.
- No cavies are permitted to be held by a member of the public.
- Entries are to be written on the official NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. application for entry and are to be sent to the entries secretary before the advertised closing date. Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted. No alterations to the entries can be made when the closing date has expired.
- All Fees are to be sent with entries and are applicable to all entries once received, there will be no refunds.
- Withdrawal of entries must be reported to the entries secretary by the Friday before the show date.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY.

Each exhibitor in consideration of the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc accepting one or more of the exhibitors applications for entry:

(a) Acknowledges and agrees that the exhibitor participates in any competition or event conducted during the show wholly and solely at the exhibitors own risk or injury to his person or property.

(b) Releases the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. and its servants and agents at the time of participation

from and against any and all liability for personal injury or damage to the exhibitors property which the exhibitor may receive, sustain or incur directly or indirectly as a result of the negligence or alleged negligence of the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. and its servants or agents aforesaid resulting from or arising out of any accident or happening whilst the exhibitor is in the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. exhibition or elsewhere under the direct or indirect control of the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. its servants or agents whether or not such accident or happening occurred whilst the exhibitor was participating in or competing in any event or competition and the exhibitor for himself, his executors, administrators and any person claiming through or under him indemnifies and holds the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. its servants and agents aforesaid indemnified from and against all claims, demands, suits, actions, damages, costs and expenses which the exhibitor or any person engaged by the exhibitor might be entitled to make or bring against or which may become payable by the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. by reason arising from or out of directly or indirectly any such accident or happening or by reason of any act or omission on the part of the exhibitor or of any person engaged by him whilst he is competing or attending to any exhibit entered by the exhibitor and the exhibitor agrees that any act or omission on his part or on the part of any such person engaged by him found in any action against the NSW CAVY CLUB Inc. to be negligent shall be deemed to be negligence for the purpose of any claim under the aforesaid indemnity.
